Eligibility Criteria

- o Must have a breast health concern
- o Must be low income
- o Must have income equal or less than 250% above the Federal Poverty Guidelines
- o Must be uninsured or underinsured (provide proof)
- o Must live in and be a resident of North Texas in counties where funding and providers are available
- o Cancer must be stage 3 or less and no distant metastasis

Services Offered

- o Early detection: mammograms, sonograms, and biopsies
- o Treatment: surgery, medical oncology (chemotherapy), radiation oncology
- o Survivorship: Breast prosthesis, mastectomy bras, wigs
- o Referral services

Fee Schedule

If the potential client does not qualify for 100% charity care at the county hospitals, and funding permits, they are treated through The Bridge.

To create an appointment:

During the intake process, they will determine if each potential client meets the guidelines and if the program can assist them. Call for a pre-screening to see if you qualify for services.

- o Pursue all available health insurance options prior to receiving JPS Connection assistance
- o Meet income guidelines

Fee Schedule

Patients can apply for JPS Connections - a program that provides assistance to patients without health insurance. Patients must submit an application to see if they qualify.

Eligibility Criteria

- o Adults (18 & above)
- o Patients must be referred by another physician
- o Patients with established diagnosis of Cancer
- o Patients currently under care of a primary care Physician (PCP)
- o Patients who are uninsured

Services Offered

- o Chemotherapy for breast cancer* (*must not be metastatic cancer)
- o Chemotherapy for colon cancer
- o Chemotherapy for some lymphomas

Fee Schedule

Services are provided at highly subsidized professional fees to make it affordable for all.

To create an appointment:

New patients must call the clinic and medical records must be sent, GDAS will then determine if they have the resources for them depending on a case-by-case basis.

Patients can speak with the Financial Services department where they will assist patients with what type of coverages they have depending on the need of the individual (there are factors to consider such as whether they reside in Dallas County, income and insurance status).

To create an appointment:

Referral has to be submitted before patient can be seen at specialty clinics. Oncology referral submitted via outside referral process via fax.

Once they receive the referral, they automatically send it to oncology clinic for an appointment to be scheduled; they will authorize the appointment, schedule it, and reach out to patient.
